Charter School Does the Math and Chooses TriEagle

Philadelphia, Pennsylvania – March 3, 2011 – The MaST Community Charter School and TriEagle Energy announced that they have entered into a two-year agreement for TriEagle to provide all of the electricity needs for the school's 1800 East Byberry Road campus.

Originally deregulated in 2000-2001, Pennsylvania has seen a recent increase in competitive energy activity as rate caps expire in many of the largest markets, including PECO, the electric distributor for Philadelphia. The competitive procurement process was handled by Metromedia Energy, a NJ-based energy consulting group licensed by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.

Metromedia estimates that MaST will save 10% over PECO's current price to compare. "It was a great opportunity for us because we are expanding into a new facility and our energy requirements will be increasing," said board member William Nolan. John Swoyer, CEO, stated that "Every dollar saved on utilities is an extra dollar we can spend on our educational programs and with energy costs rising, this is significant for our school moving forward."

"We are delighted that they did the math and we could 'add' The MaST Community Charter School to our growing list of Pennsylvania customers," said Rob Cantrell, TriEagle's SVP of Sales and Chief Marketing Officer.
